



WellCare Medicaid HEDIS Measures Definitions

1. **Cervical Cancer Screening**
Percentage of women 21–64 years of age who were screened for cervical cancer using either of the following criteria:
 - Women age 21–64 who had cervical cytology performed every 3 years.
 - Women age 30–64 who had cervical cytology/human papillomavirus (HPV) co-testing performed every 5 years.

2. **Child BMI**
Percentage of patients 3-17 years of age with at least one outpatient visit with a primary care physician (PCP) or an obstetrician/gynecologist (OB/GYN) during the measurement period who had a height, weight and body mass index (BMI) percentile recorded.

3. **Chlamydia Testing**
Percentage of women 16-24 years of age who were identified as sexually active and who had at least one test for chlamydia during the measurement period.

4. **Diabetes Dilated Eye Exam**
Percentage patients with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had an eye exam (retinal) performed during the measurement year.

5. **Mammogram**
Percentage of women 50 to 74 years of age who had a mammogram to screen for breast cancer during the measurement year or the year prior to the measurement period.

6. **Prenatal Visit (Timeliness)**
Percentage of deliveries that received a prenatal care visit as a member of the organization in the first trimester, on the enrollment start date or within 42 days of enrollment in the organization

7. **Adolescent Well Visit**
Patients age 2 – 20 years who have at least one well visit within the measurement year.

8. **Diabetes HbA1c <=9**
Percentage of patients age 18-75 with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) whose most recent HbA1c level is less than 9% during the measurement year.

9. **Diabetes HbA1c Test**
Percentage of patients age 18-75 with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) whose had a HbA1c test during the measurement year.

10. Diabetes Monitor Nephropathy

Percentage of patients age 18-75 with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had medical attention for nephropathy during the measurement year.

11. Well Child 15 Mos Visit (6+)

Children who turn 15 months of age during the measurement year and have received six or more well-child visits since birth.

12. Well Child 3-6 year old Visit

Children 3-6 years of age in the measurement year who had at least one well-care visit with a PCP during the measurement year.
