- TCM billed without an interactive patient communication which should be within 2 business days
  of discharge.
  - Though TCM encounter is appropriate after hospital discharge, be sure to look for the TCM phone call or patient outreach before billing TCM code.
- TCM billed after Emergency Department visits and should only be billed after an Inpatient or Observation Stay
  - Make sure before billing a TCM code that the patient had a discharge summary from an inpatient or observation stay as it is required that you review the discharge summary for TCM.
- TCM billed without Medical Decision Making or only moderate complexity MDM billed with 99496.
  - TCM visit 99495 requires moderate MDM.
    - Prescription drug management by discussing the changes in medications or new medications prescribed.
    - Reviewing tests and labs from hospital stay OR ordering new tests and labs.
    - Documenting if social determinants of health significantly limit treatment.
    - Independent interpretation of tests performed in the hospital.
    - Addressing the diagnoses that were addressed in the hospital.
  - TCM visit 99496 requires high MDM.
    - The chronic illness has severe exacerbation or progression after hospital stay requiring re-hospitalization.
    - The acute/chronic illness may pose threat to life or bodily function.
    - Decision to de-escalate care or DNR due to poor prognosis.
    - Drug therapy prescribed in the hospital requires intensive monitoring for toxicity.
    - 2 of 3 components for data
      - (3) hospital tests reviewed or ordering new tests
      - Independent interpretation of hospital tests
      - Discussion of management or interpretation of tests by another provider
- Use the TCM expressway and smart phrase available.
  - The TCM expressway will allow you to document the date of admission, date of discharge and TCM phone call.
